

Village of Rothbury Council Meeting September 21, 2021

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Rothbury Village Council was opened in the Village Hall by President Scott Beishuizen with all council members present.

Also present were: Police Chief Tom Hasper, Sgt. Ethan Walker, Bob Fulljames, Barb Thompson, Domo Cruz, Cliff Cudney, Jessica Beggs, Norm and Susan Halbower, and Grant Township Trustee Joan Brooks.

After the pledge of allegiance, the previous minutes and the monthly Treasurer's report were presented to council. The minutes were approved as presented.

Harris made a motion, seconded by Fekken to adopt the amended budget presented by the Clerk for fiscal year 2021-22 based on actual anticipated revenues, as recommended by the auditor. Motion carried, 7 ayes, 0 nays.

Police Chief Hasper gave the monthly report.

Discussion of the grant received from the Oceana County Community Foundation included a decision to dedicate the new picnic shelter in memory of Recreation Director Nancy Rolf who has recently passed away.

Nancy Rolf's daughter Jessica Beggs was present to inform the council that Nancy had started the planning for both the Halloween party and the Craft Fair. Jessica agreed to take over

the role of Recreation Director until the end of the year with the help of the council. Halloween will again be a drive-through event at the Community Center to be celebrated on Sunday, October 30, 2021.

Harris made a motion, seconded by Drake to pay the bills. Motion carried 7 ayes, 0 nays.

Meeting stood adjourned at 7:20 PM.
