

Village of Rothbury Council Meeting

February 20, 2024

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Rothbury Village Council was called to order in the Village Hall at 7:00 p.m. by President Vern Talmadge.

Council members present were Mike Harris, Autumn Drake, Denise Kurdziel, Troy Voorhees, and Dylan Zuniga. Absent was Jim Fekken.

Also in attendance were; Treasurer Deb Murphy, Deputy Clerk Carol Witzke, Sgt. Ethan Walker, DPW Scott Beishuizen, Cliff Cudney, Rich Canniff, Sheri Canniff, Renee Voorhees, Ted Kurdziel and Steve Salter.

The prior meetings minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurer Deb Murphy gave the monthly Treasurers report, and informed Council that the additional Mass Gathering Fees have been received from The Electric Forest Festival.

Sgt. Walker gave the monthly police report and advised the the old patrol car is decommissioned and ready to be auctioned off. Councils consensus was to list with Ranger Bid.

Mike Harris gave the Planning Commission update, there was no meeting held in February.

Vaughn White from Valley City Metal spoke to the council requesting a resolution of support in securing funding for clean up efforts at the Valley City Metal site.

Motion made by Mike Harris, seconded by Autumn Drake to approve the resolution as presented.

Discussion between council members on wishlist items for the upcoming budget year.

Motion by Autumn Drake to pay the bills, with support from Mike Harris. 6 ayes, 0 nays. Motion passed.

Motion by Mike Harris, seconded by Dylan Zuniga to extend Carol Witzke as Deputy Clerk for an additional 6 months. 6 ayes, 0 nays, motion passed.

Public Comment, discussion of blight within the Village.
